JAKE NEEDHAM WHEN YOU ARE A NOVELIST IN BANGKOK

Last week's presentation by novelist Jake Needham focused on the attitudes and misconceptions of the media in the USA, and of many Americans and others regarding life in Bangkok and Thailand. Quoting from a number of well-known writers, Jake regaled Rotarians and their guests with several examples of sensationalist writing, including authors Michael Connelly, Stephen Hunter and John Sandford. He also mentioned lead actors in TV series like House of Cards and Inspector Morse and Jack Nicholson, who refer to Bangkok as the place to go for sex and sin.

Originally from Houston, Texas, Jake Needham is one of the best-selling English-language authors in Asia. A frequent speaker at schools and universities throughout Asia, he has written eight crime novels, plus a number of screenplays for television and the cinema. A graduate of Rice University with a Bachelor degree in History and Economics, he also holds a Master's degree in Law from Georgetown University. His Thai wife is a graduate of Oxford University and they and their two sons reside in Thailand and the USA. Reading extracts from his novels



The Big Mango and The Laundry Man, he went on to delight the audience when describing a phone call from the late James Gandolfini, the lead actor in The Sopranos, who expressed keen interest in developing The Big Mango novel into a major film production. When the deal eventually fell through, Jake received an ominous phone call from Gandolfini, which was reminiscent of a scene straight from The Sopranos!

Returning to the question of Bangkok's

detractors. He quoted one correspondent who wrote that "all foreigners should leave Thailand and leave it to be enjoyed by the Thais". On checking the postmark it was revealed that the writer now resides in New York!

A question and answer session followed the presentation, mainly involving Rotarians originally from the USA. This was followed by the presentation of a certificate of appreciation by P. Narain.

INTER-CLUB DELEGATION TO RC DHONBURI

On Wednesday 19 August, 2015, President Narain led a delegation of seven Rotary Club Bangkok South (RCBS) Members to the first Inter-Club Delegation visit of the 2015/2016 Rotary Year to Rotary Club Dhonburi, the second club to be chartered in Thailand and home club of Past RI President Pichai Rattakun, at their regular club meeting at the Narai Hotel. RCBS were joined by delegations from other Rotary Clubs based in Bangkok, including RC Bangkok, RC Bangkokpi and RC Srapathum.



We received a warm welcome from President Sutthiphong Pheunphiphop and the members of RC Dhonburi and the meeting presented an excellent opportunity for fellowship, exchanges of ideas and promotion of the key projects and events of the Clubs in attendance, including our own Coins on Silom (30 October 2015), RC Bangkok's 85th Birthday Dinner at Grand Hyatt Erawan on 14 September 2015 and RC Bangkokpi's Kids Day Out in 2016.

A program of club delegations was first initiated in the 2007/2008 Rotary Year under President Graham Brain, with the intention of promoting more interaction between RCBS and other Rotary Clubs in the Bangkok area, and proved to be well received by the Clubs that we visited who decided to participate, creating the "Inter-Club delegations". After a brief lull in Inter-Club delegations, the current RCBS Board under the leadership of President Narain resolved to reactivate these visits, inviting six Bangkok Clubs to participate in the current Rotary Year, plus our daughter club RC Royal Hua Hin,

which hosts an annual Inter-Club Fellowship Dinner in either late January/early February each year.
